



Action After School 2010-2011

The YMCA of Iredell County is offering an after school program for the 2010-2011 school year. The program is designed for boys and girls in Kindergarten – 12 years old. The program is located at the YMCA of Iredell County.

The YMCA will pick up registered children at the following schools:

Cost: \$ 58 per week for YMCA Members full time
 \$ 80 per week for Potential Members full time
 \$ 35 for a three-day week for YMCA members
 \$ 52 for a three-day week for potential members

Policies and Procedures

Pick-up

Pick up your child/children no later than 6:00 p.m. each day. There will be a \$5 late fee for each minute after 6 p.m. for each child that is picked-up late. This fee must be paid in cash. Your child will not be allowed to return until this late fee is paid.

Please call 704-873-9622, ext. 225 if you are going to be late.

Operating Schedule

Our program operates on the ISS schedule. We will try to offer our services on other school system schedules, but this is not guaranteed.

Attendance

If your child will not be attending on certain days, you will need to call and let us know. This way we are not waiting for your child at the school. If your child is sick and you have a doctor's note you will be given credit. If you do not have a doctor's note or if you are on vacation, no credit will be given. We do not give credit for dentist appointments of any kind. Attendance is taken everyday. Once you sign up for the after school program you are reserving a spot for your child for the entire year. You will be billed for this amount whether your child attends or not. Money from the after school program **can not** be transferred to other programs.

If your child is expelled or suspended from school, he or she will not be allowed to attend after school until he or she is allowed to return to school.

If you wish to cancel your registration for After School, you must speak to Becky Walker **ONLY**, and **give a written 2 week notice**. You will be responsible for payment of 2 weeks after canceling your child's registration.

Payments

Payments can be made by:

1. Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT): Payments for After School will be made by EFT. These payments may be made weekly, biweekly, or monthly. Please see Becky Walker if you need specific dates.

A reminder that the after school program fee is due the **Friday before** the week your child is enrolled in the program. **If payment is not made by 6:00 pm on Friday, a \$10 late fee will be added to your weekly payment.**

Swim Days

Your child will need to bring a bathing suit and towel on his/her swim day. The schedule will be given out the first week of After School. Please label all of your child's belongings. They will be responsible to keep track of their items.

Things Not to Bring

Toys, radios, CD players, video games, etc. are not allowed to the YMCA After School Program. We realize that these are valuable items and ask that they be kept at home.

Things to Bring

- Sneakers need to be worn during gym time. Children are not allowed to play in the gym when wearing sandals. This helps prevent injuries.
- Weather appropriate clothing: Please plan accordingly for your child to play outside. Jackets and coats will be needed as the seasons begin to change.
- Notes will be sent home if anything special is planned during after school.

Snow Day Policy

The YMCA of Iredell County has implemented the following policy for inclement weather:

When school is dismissed due to snow, sleet, or freezing rain, the YMCA will **NOT** pick up the children at school.

A message will be left on the answering machine at the YMCA if the Y is closed due to weather. This message will advise you when the Y will be open and what programs will be running. A decision will be made by 8 a.m.

Short School Weeks

On school scheduled short weeks, (anything less than 5 days). We will adjust the price of the short weeks according to the number of days. See chart below:

3 Days: \$35.00
2 Days: \$25.00
1 Day: \$12.50

Potential Member Daily Rates:

5 Days: \$80.00
4 Days: \$67.00
3 Days: \$52.00

1 Day: \$20.00
