



The YMCA offers quality programs during the year for children. These programs are well-staffed and stress character building and values. We do not have the staff to monitor children who are dropped off and are not registered in a program. These children are restricted to certain hours:

- No staff person will be available for tending to any child who is not accompanied by an adult.
- Children under 18 are not allowed in the facilities, before 3 p.m. during school days without adult supervision.
- During non-school days, no children under 16 can be dropped off before 1 p.m. unless they are enrolled in a class or using the facilities for workout or practice routines.
- From 1 – 5 p.m., children under 16 may come in alone and use the facilities for programs or for recreation. Check the schedule for open swim in the pool and/or open gym times.
- From 5 p.m. until closing, children under 16 must be in a program or using the facilities for workout or recreational use. Loitering, roaming the halls, hanging out anywhere in the building or disruption of classes is not allowed.
- Any behavior contrary to YMCA values – caring, honesty, respect, responsibility – towards members, staff or guests will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.
- The YMCA reserves the right to restrict visitors and those with guest passes any times it is warranted.

We stress the concern and safety of all our members. If a child is dropped off and causes problems at the YMCA, we will handle the situation on a case-by-case basis. Discipline will vary according to offense. It can consist of being talked to, suspended for a period of time or permanent revocation of membership.
